





#### TEACHERS' ORIENTATION PROGRAMME



- Watermelon Blast Demonstrating explosive forces in a fun and messy way!
- Centripetal Board Showing the magic of centripetal force and motion.
- Coanda Effect Exploring how fluids interact with surfaces.
- Resonance Tube Creating standing sound waves and observing resonance.
- Acetone Gas Rocket Launching mini rockets powered by simple chemical reactions!
